

Regulation for Honorary Membership

Regulation agreed by Council – 18 January 2014





1. Honorary Members of the Society

- 1.1 An Honorary Member is appointed by a decision of the Executive Committee, or a decision of the Council if the Executive Committee is unable to meet. Honorary Membership shall be open to all members of the multi professional clinical team or non-clinical individuals, who have made a significant contribution to the practice of intensive care (which could be due to clinical commitment, innovation, the contribution to, or completion of research, education, service development, management and/or leadership) as judged by the Executive Committee members or Council members appointing that Honorary Member acting in their sole discretion.
- 1.2 The number of Honorary Members appointed each year shall not exceed a number equal to more than 0.1% of the total ICS Members at the time of appointment.

2. **Rights of Honorary Members**

- 2.1 Honorary Members who are eligible to be ICS Members will automatically become ICS Members, and shall retain the rights of ICS Members as set out in these Council Regulations and the Articles of Association from time to time, but shall not be required to pay any membership subscription to the Society.
- 2.2 Registration fees for the Society's State of the Art Congress may be waived for Honorary Members by the Executive Committee or Council from time to time, acting in their sole discretion. (Such waivers may be reviewed from time to time by the Executive Committee or Council.)
